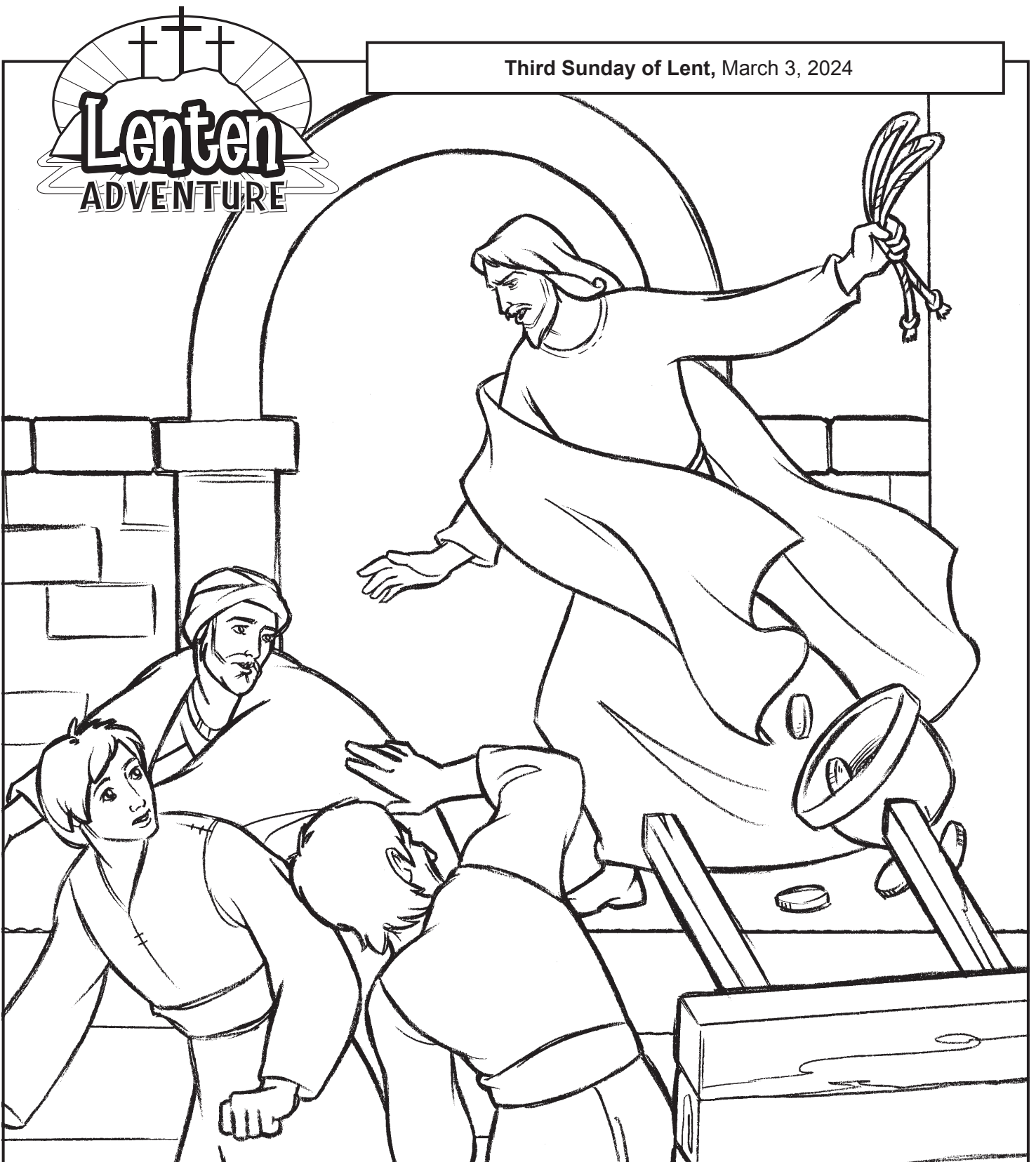


Third Sunday of Lent, March 3, 2024
